MILWAUKEE ROAD WAS TRAVELED
 FROM THE EARLY SETTLERS EVEN BEFORE
 THE GOVERNMENT SURVEY. F. C. ROSSITER,
 DEPT. COUNTY SURVEYOR, BY ORDER OF THE
 DEPT. COUNTY BOARD - SURVEYED MILWAUKEE
 AVE. 25 FT. WIDE FROM THE BOUNDARY LINE
 TO ALLESTON'S BRIDGE IN WHELFIELD -
 PLAT WAS FILED WITH THE TOWN CLERK
 ABOUT 1875.

IN 1872 F. C. ROSSITER AS DEPUTY COUNTY
 SURVEYOR WAS EMPLOYED BY THE COUNTY
 TO INTERVIEW ALL PROPERTY OWNERS IN
 WHEELING TOWNSHIP TO COPY DEEDS AND RECORDS
 FOR THE COUNTY CLERK AND ASSESSOR.

IN 1873 F. C. ROSSITER WAS EMPLOYED BY THE
 COUNTY AND TOWNSHIP TO REPLACE WOOD
 STAKES - WITH LIMESTONE 6" x 2 1/2" x 3" AT ALL
 GOVERNMENT CORNERS - AT WHICH TIME ABOUT
 65 PER CENT OF THE ORIGINAL GOVT. CORNERS
 OR WITNESS TREES WERE IN EXISTENCE AT THAT
 TIME.

F. C. ROSSITER DID NOT USE BOULDERS
 ALL WHENSCHES WERE PLACED WITH TOPS AT
 THE NATURAL SURFACE OF THE SOIL.


WHEELING - DRAINAGE DISTRICT
