Funeral Mass for Isabell Blocks
(nee Weidner), 88, of Fox Lake, for-
merly of Prairie View, will be held at
10 a.m. Tuesday, at St. Mary Catholic
Church in Buffalo Grove.
Born May 22, 1910, in Prairie View,
she died Saturday, June 6, 1998, at
Lake Forest Hospital. Burial will be
in St. Mary Cemetery, Buffalo Grove.
A lifelong Lake County resident, she
