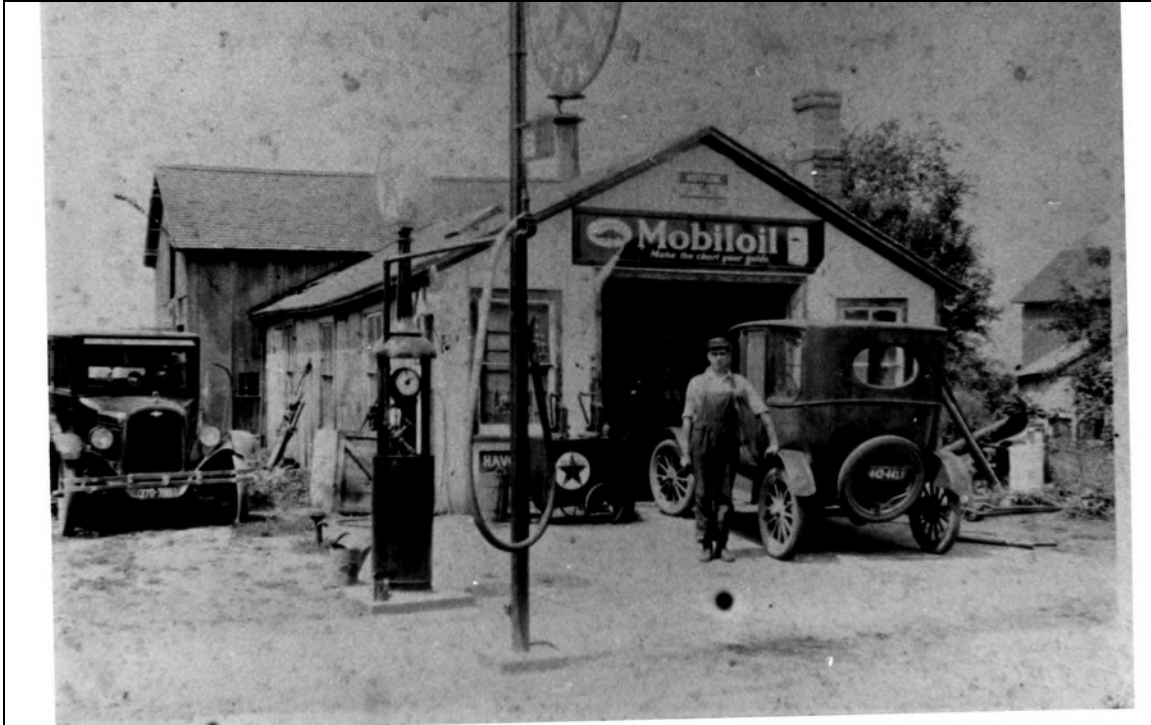

First prize photo in the contest at the Wheeling Historical Society's Old Settlers Picnic was this view of the former Crawford's ice cream parlor at the southeast corner of Milwaukee Ave. and Dundee Road. In 1921 it became the site of the Wheeling State Bank, the town's first. The photo is by Lucille Schneider, who with her sister Adeline, is among Wheeling's oldest natives. The bank was established by a group of local businessmen, in the ice cream parlor which had been built onto Fassbender's hardware store (at

right) in 1914. Six years after it was founded, the bank moved across the street to its own building on the southwest corner, and was known as Wheeling Trust and Savings Bank. Now it is located just east of the filling station on the northeast corner and is The Main Bank of Wheeling. After the bank moved out, the ice cream parlor became a delicatessen, and then a tavern. Eventually it was torn down and its site now is marked by a planting at the corner of Riverside Plaza.

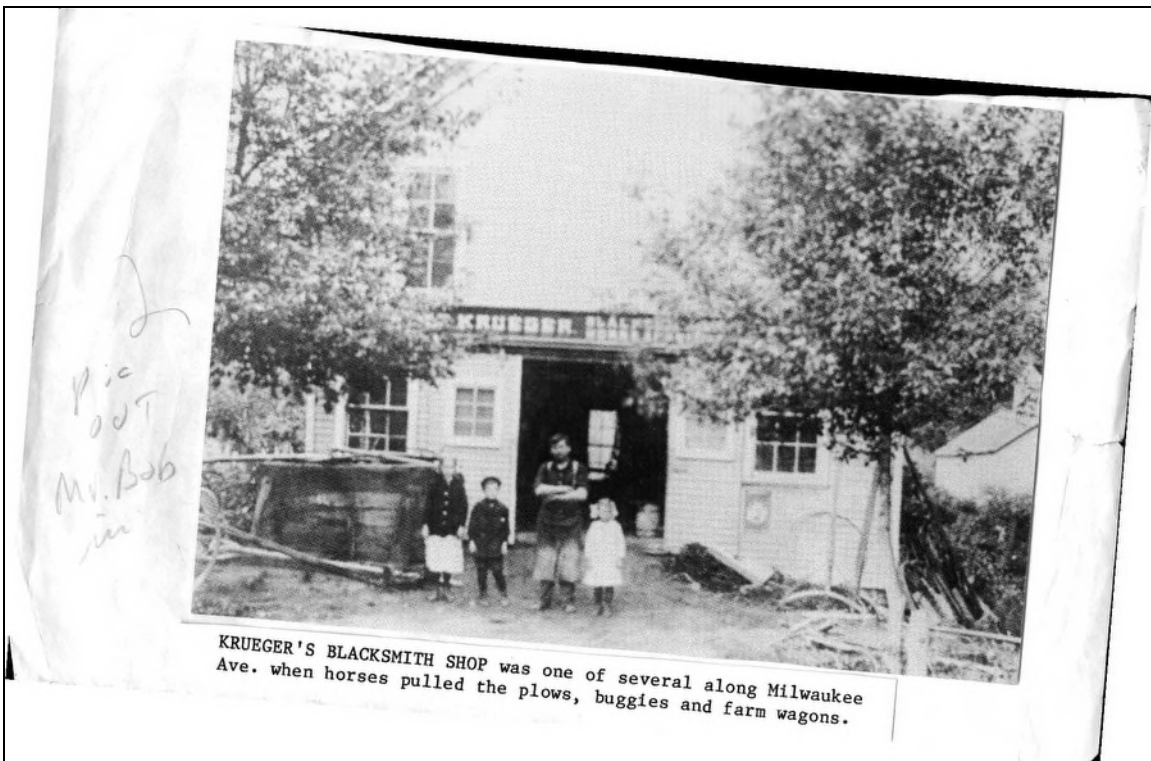

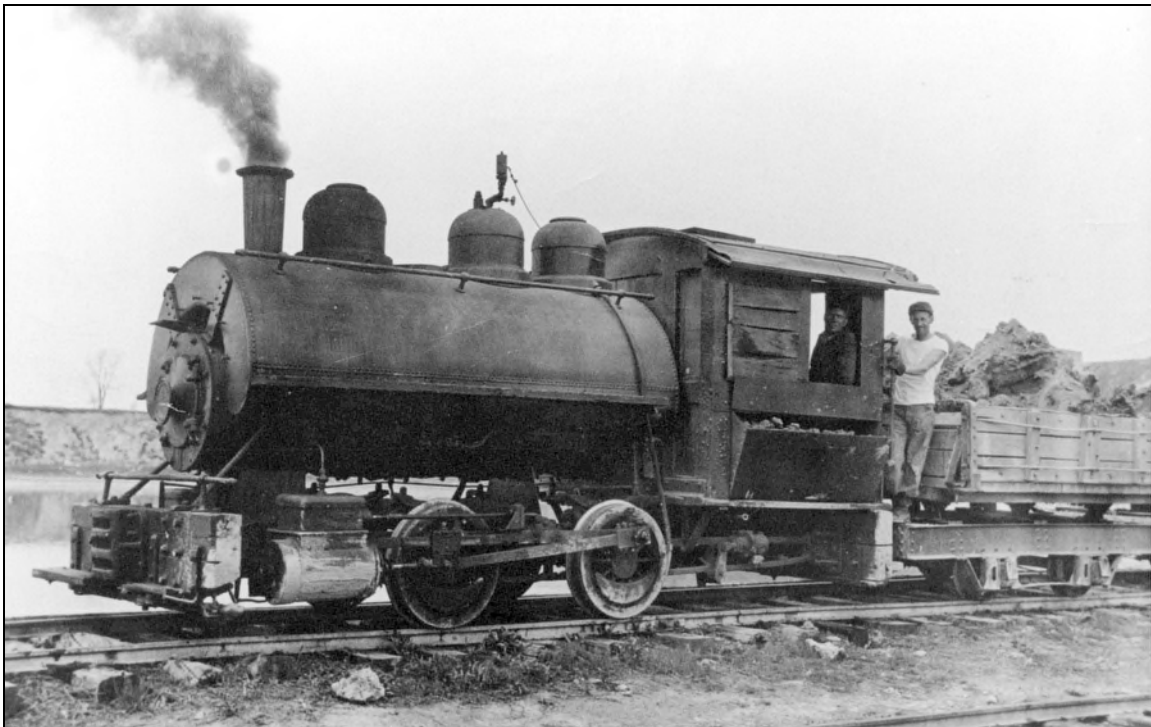

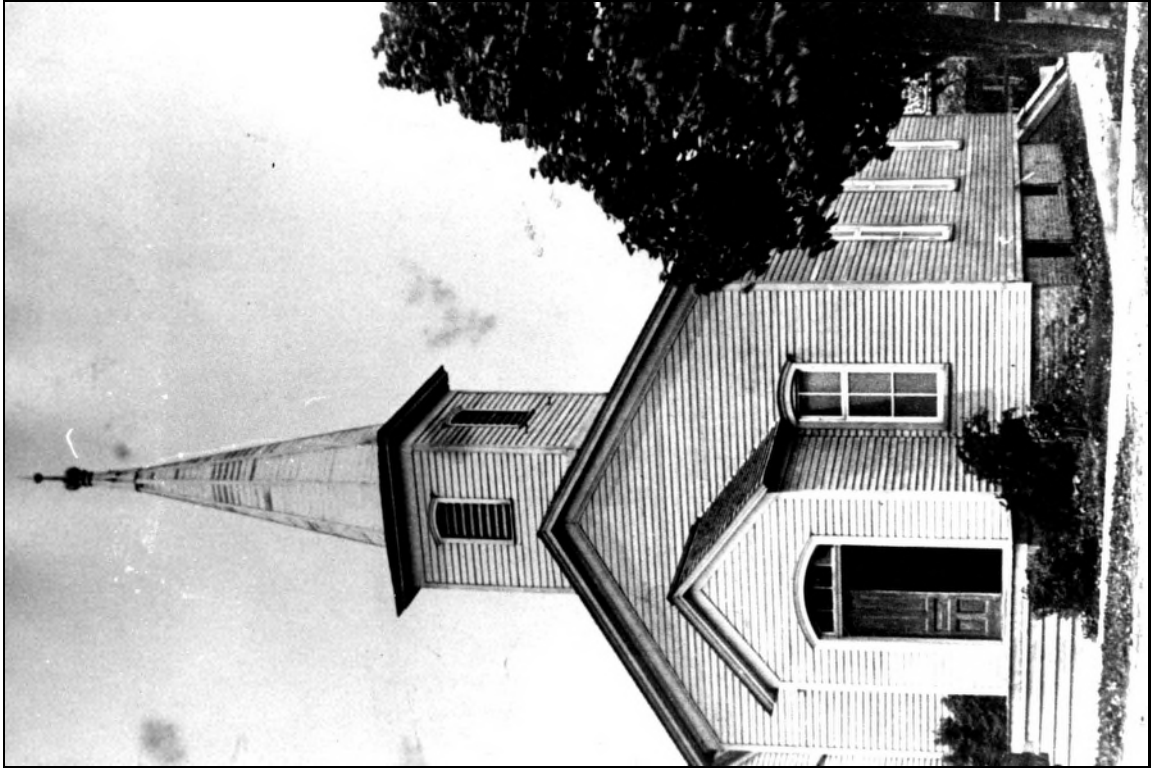

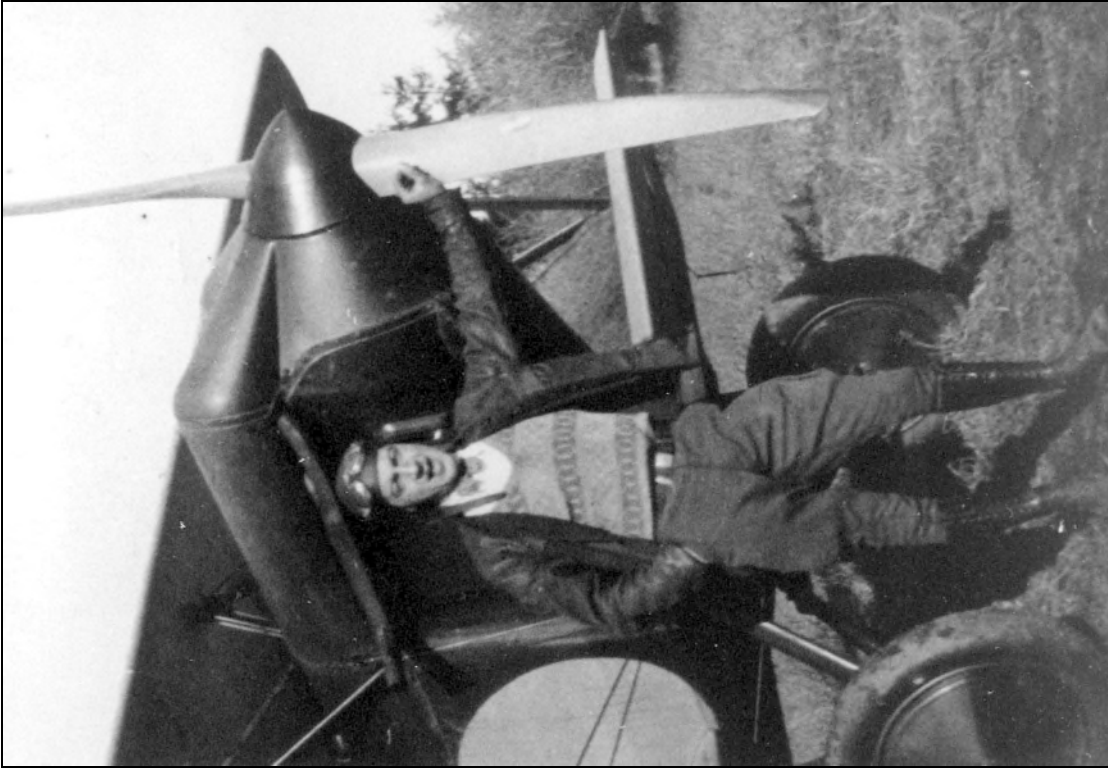
