Register of Money Order Advices Received.

INSTRUCTIONS FOR THE USE OF THIS BOOK.

The particulars of every Advice received of an Order drawn upon this office are to be recorded in this volume. It is the permanent record, hence the entries should not only be legibly written, but should be correct in every particular.

Examine Advices.—~~Never~~ *Never enter upon record the particulars of an Advice until you shall have examined it and ascertained therefrom that it is drawn upon your office.* It happens occasionally that Advices are by accident mailed to offices other than those to which they were intended to be sent, hence the Postmaster should make it a rule, not to be departed from, to always carefully examine each Advice, immediately upon its receipt, and, if found to be intended for another office, and evidently sent to his office through mistake, mail it forthwith to its destination. No record of its receipt is to be made in this book or elsewhere; write the word "missent" on the upper margin, and place upon its face an impression of your dating stamp, thus indicating to the paying Postmaster the cause of delay in its receipt.

Stamp Advices.—Stamp every Advice, upon receipt, in the space provided therefor upon back of Advice, at upper left-hand corner.

Remitter, Payee, &c.—Fill in the spaces under the several headings, indicating number, place of issue, name of remitter, name of payee, amount, &c.

Date of Payment.—File the Advices until the corresponding Orders are paid. Immediately upon payment of an Order stamp the date of payment upon the Order and upon the corresponding Advice—the latter upon the back, at the upper right-hand corner, in the space provided therefor. Write the corresponding date in this book, under the heading "Date when paid," which ordinarily completes the transaction and the record.

File Advices.—File the paid Advices, preserving them for a period of four years, when they may be disposed of as waste paper. It is advisable to file them alphabetically, by name of office, by quarters, according to date of issue.

~~Never~~ Statements are to be prepared from the paid Orders, not from this book.

Repayment.—If notice of repayment of an Order is received, write, under head of "remarks," the sentence, "Repaid.....(give date) 189...." Write a similar sentence across face of the Advice, attach thereto the notice of repayment, and file as in the case of paid Advices.

Duplicates.—While an Order is good for the amount for an indefinite period, payment may not be made upon the original after a period of one year from date of issue has elapsed, but a duplicate may be issued by the Department (not by a Postmaster) at any time thereafter, if application therefor be made upon the blank provided for that purpose. A duplicate of a lost Order may be applied for at any time (actual evidence of loss is not necessary). The object of this record is, therefore, to preserve, in permanent form, all the particulars necessary to enable the Postmaster to sign the certificate he is required to make prior to the issue of a duplicate. Under the head of "remarks," record is to appear, showing the date when such certificate is made, viz.: "Duplicate applied for,.....189...."
